

Pack Time Policy at Cedarcrest High School

Our Mission

PACK Time is designated for academic intervention and extension, allowing students to receive targeted support or enrichment. Its purpose is to maximize student learning and achievement

Expectations

- Students will select their PACK Time session each week based on their individual learning needs.
- If a teacher assigns a student to a specific PACK Time, this takes priority over student choice.
- If a student needs additional support in mastering essential learnings in any class, this takes priority over attending clubs, CTSO meetings, or other events during PACK Time.
- Students are expected to attend their assigned or chosen session on time and remain for the full duration.
- PACK Time is intended for academic intervention, enrichment, or extension activities—students are expected to actively engage in the purpose of their session.
- Attendance and participation in PACK Time are required and will be monitored.
- Failure to use PACK Time appropriately may result in progressive disciplinary action (see below).

Consequences

1st Offense: Verbal warning

2nd Offense: Lunch detention assigned; parent phone call home

3rd Offense: One hour after school detention assigned; parent phone call home

4th Offense: Two-hour after school detention assigned; parent phone call home

5th Offense: Three-hour after school detention assigned; parent/student/admin meeting
